

PROPOSED GUIDELINES FOR 4-H COUNCIL EXPENDITURES 2025-2026

Leader: A club project leader or a county-wide leader must be designated as such in the office.

Mileage or Transportation: Mileage will be paid for those providing transportation that the Phillips-Rooks Extension District Office arranges for. Mileage rate will be the rate currently being paid by the State.

CONFERENCES AND CAMPS

- 4-H Council will pay toward conferences and camps as long as the member(s) work a shift in the Rooks County Free Fair 4-H Food Stand.
- 4-H Council will pay \$150 toward registration fees.
- Judging Events: Other than State Fair - If the group attends an event that necessitates an overnight stay, it will be considered individually by 4-H Council.
- National Contest: Group submits request to 4-H Council on as-needed basis.

COUNTY WIDE PROJECTS: Group submits request to 4-H Council. The allowance for Dog, Horse and Shooting Sports Projects is to be spent to the benefit of all the project members. Allowances will be based on the following:
